- Fire safety!!! With a lack of rain and abundant wind our area has become exceedingly dry. Please plan to mow your grasses as soon as they begin to get tall. Trim up tree limbs and remove dead limbs. Reduce road side combustibles - the County is NOT going to do it for you.
- Roadside trash. The snow is no longer hiding the roadside trash so if you could take a plastic bag along on your walks and collect some of the litter, your efforts would be most appreciated by all of your neighbors.
- Dog waste. For some reason there seem to be several dog owners who collect their dogs poop in a plastic bag and then leave the plastic bag on the side of the road. I know of NO SERVICE that is going to come along behind you and pick up your poop baggies. Please, be a responsible dog owner and collect and dump your dog's leavings. It just is a part of owning a dog.
