There are several openings on the Board. We encourage you to join the Board. Below is a partial list of services that the Civic Association provides:

- Douglas County contact for proposed changes to County regulations including zoning regulations.
- Douglas County contact for workshops, seedling, recycling efforts.
- Douglas County contact for building permits within the neighborhood.
- Douglas County contact for road and maintenance changes.
- South Metro Fire contact for training exercises, workshops, alerts, restrictions.
- Fire Wise Neighborhood Certification and program renewal for insurance discounts.
- Neighborhood communication and social events such as: Picnic, Mailbox contest, robberies, unusual activities or people.
- Dumpster Day and other fire prevention, or trail clearing events.
- Water adjudication and administration of water rights under our neighborhood.

Openings for Officers, members, and even non-voting committee chairs need filling. The Ponderosa Hills Civic Association is an all-voluntary non-profit organization. The typical service period is two years and the Board meets each month for two hours. You must be a member of the PHCA in good standing to join the board and only one owner of a property can be a voting member.

The meeting agenda is being firmed up but likely topics are: election of Board, Discussion of Signage for the Development, Presentation of the CALF program, discussion of traffic issues at entrances and on the roads through the neighborhood, presentation on noxious weed removal.
